Fire Ants - What are they?

Fire Ants are serious pests. They have now been found in Tin Shui Wai, Yuen Long. They cause a painful sting. By the time they sting, there may be tens or hundreds of ants on your body. They pose a serious danger to our lifestyle and the environment if not eliminated.


What do they look like?

Fire ants look very much like ordinary house or garden ants.

Fire ants:



- Are small
- Are coppery-brown in color on the head and body, with a darker abdomen
- Come in a variety of sizes within one nest, ranging from 2mm to 6 mm. This is an unique characteristic of fire ants
- Have nests with no clear entry or exit holes on top of them
- Can be found out by their aggressive behavior, especially near the nest



Fire ant colonies are basically of two types: those with only one queen and those with more than one fertile queen. Mature fire ant colonies can contain 200 000 to 400 000 workers.

Their nests can appear as dome-shaped mounds, up to 40cm high, or underneath other objects found on the ground, such as timber and rocks. Mounds are usually found in open areas such as along roadsides and unused farmland. Mounds are seldom found in frequently cultivated areas.

About the sting

Fire ants have a sting in their tail, similar to bees. However, unlike bees, fire ants can sting repeatedly. Stings from fire ants can cause a painful, burning and itching feeling, which can last for an hour. The feeling made by multiple stings is that the body is on fire; so, the name fire ant.

First aid

Apply a cold compress or ice as soon as possible to the affected areas to reduce swelling and reduce pain. To prevent secondary infection, wash the affected areas gently with soap and water and be careful not to break them.
